Down Syndrome Assn. of Imperial County	Imperial Valley Buddy Walk: 8th Annual Buddy Walk is a tradition among community members who promote acceptance and inclusion of individuals with Down Syndrome. Funds will be used to print brochures about the event, offset travel expenses, and for the rental of tables and chairs for the day of the event.	900.00
Imperial County Free Library	Every Child Ready to Read: ICFL will be offering parent and child storytime trainings based on the "Every Child Ready to Read" curriculum at 3 ICFL branches and one outreach location in Seeley. The project will give away books to each family and will create bags with further reading on each of the five activities. Funds will be used to purchase books and print brochures.	1,500.00
